FSET (FoodShare Employment and Training) is a **free** Employment and Training program for anyone 16 and older who gets FoodShare. We're here to help you find the career that works for you. And participating in FSET is one way to meet the FoodShare work requirement.

## FSET can help you find a career you love



**Personalized Support** – Work one-on-one with a case manager who is there to provide help and encouragement.



**Career Preparation** – Build experience, education, a winning resume and interview skills.



**Job leads** – Connect you with local jobs that match your strengths and interests.



**Training** – Assist you in finding trainings, apprenticeships, and certification programs.



**Supportive services** – Help you pay for things you need like work clothes, transportation, books, and tools. Ask your FSET team what's available for you.



**Continued Support** – After you get a job, FSET gives 90 days of support to help make sure everything goes well.
